Bread and Wine for Communion

The early church met in homes and their life together was built upon a common meal. They blessed, broke, gave and shared what they had brought and so looked to fulfill what Jesus had asked them to do at supper the night before he died.

“Whenever you gather in my name, do this in remembrance of me.” That 'Last Supper' is, of course, the core of our common life, Sunday by Sunday. And marking the beginning of each real celebration is the offertory procession – the bearing of gifts – bread, wine, and money: we formally present who we are and what we have, moving through the nave of the church up to the altar. That 'we' is all of us, symbolized by those actually bringing the gifts – ideally a mix of single folks and families, young and old and everyone in between. Like the Body of Christ all over the world, we assemble, offer gifts and gather at the rail side by side to be fed.

In hopes of offertory processions that reflect the breadth of our community, we began in the fall with the Godly Play families bringing up the Bread and Wine. It seemed a particularly helpful way to involve young children in the flow of the liturgy. But hopefully this opportunity can extend to all members of Fork Church. Enclosed is a list of most of the members of our congregation and the date that we have assigned to bring the Bread and Wine forward. We began at the beginning of the alphabet and assigned dates beginning with February 24 and going through June 9th. If you cannot be at church on your assigned date try to trade with someone. If this does not work for you please let us know. If you are

a single person just ask anyone that you would like to help you. If anyone would like to make the communion bread for their assigned date please let me [Boo] know and I will send you a recipe. This is a fun activity for you and your children or youth.
