The answer to that question may seem too obvious to be interesting or even require articulation. But I disagree. I believe that the answer to the question, like a well-crafted poem or piece of art, only appears obvious. However, the more time you spend with it, the more it opens into unfathomable depths. So, from this Sunday, Sept 7 through Sunday, Nov 23, I'd like us to explore as *a* church this question: *What is the Church?*

To that end, Don Schubert and I will make this question the theme of the Adult Forum, meeting each Sunday at 9am. I will also find ways of addressing the question in my sermons during this season. That doesn't mean that this question will be the topic of each sermon, but it will be something like the refrain we return to in light of the different passages of scripture we encounter every Sunday.
