Godly Play Fall 2012

We are about to begin another exciting year using the Godly Play curriculum in our Fork Church Sunday School program. Ann Neri will help us for one more year. She will teach the older group, I will again work with the younger children and Angela will also be teaching with us and **WE NEED MORE PEOPLE TO HELP!!!**

Our first Sunday of Sunday School will be September 9th and we will begin in church where Bill Wells will bless the children and the teachers and send us off to our class.

Both groups will begin the year with the story of Creation and the beginning of an Old Testament Time Line where we will place the core Old Testament stories in sequence with the stories of the Old Testament heroes. For example: under the story of creation we will place the story of Adam and Eve. This will give the children a visual picture of how all of our stories fit together.

Simultaneously with our Old Testament stories and our timeline we will study some of the Saints of the church. On November 11th the Godly Play children will host the coffee hour and present a Saints project they will have been working on during the fall.

The 4th and 5th graders will create with Ann Neri their own Circle of the Holy Eucharist and will attend church with her once a month as they learn about the service and what all of the things on the altar are and what the priest is doing. You will see them sitting up front with their Circle of the Holy Eucharist cards keeping watch on Bill Wells.

We will make Advent Wreaths in the Parish House Kitchen after church on the Sunday after Thanksgiving. We will not have Sunday School that day. Jim and I will bring live greens and we will have supplies for all who sign up to make wreaths, more about this at a later date.

During Advent we will "get ready" for the great event of Christmas.

On December 23 during the regular church service we will present our Advent Play complete with children taking different parts and someone narrating the play. On Christmas Eve at the 5:00pm children's service we will finish the Christmas Story with our large creche.

After Christmas we will celebrate the season of Epiphany and move right into Lent. On the Sunday closest to Ash Wednesday we will process into the church with out Allelulia Banners and
